

Wizard Interface Changes

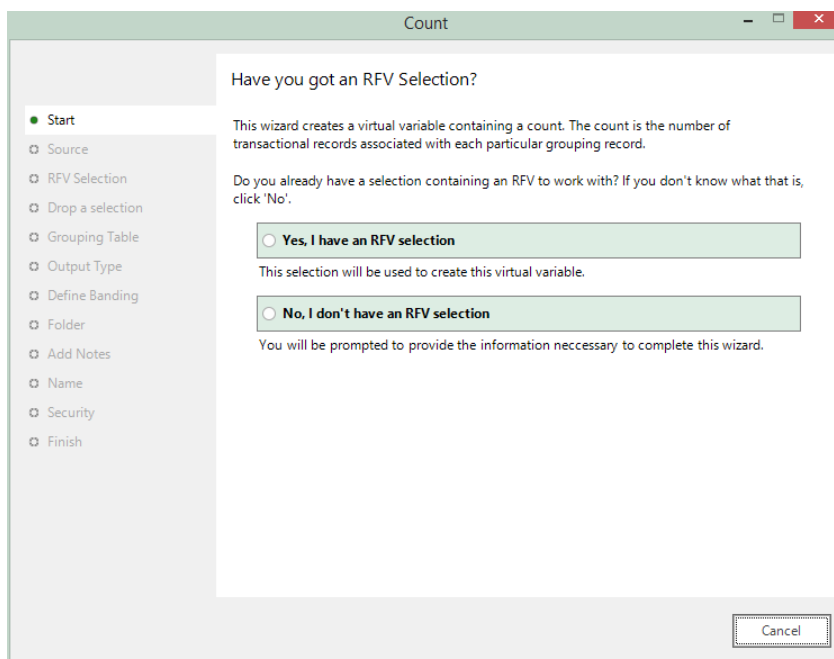

Summary

All wizards have been updated with the latest style guidelines from Microsoft.

All previous functionality has been incorporated into the new style wizards. To illustrate the style changes, the following example uses the Count wizard.

- Open the Count wizard



The first difference to note is that the images in the left hand panel of a step have now been removed. This area has been replaced with a list of all the steps in the wizard.

New titles and the removal of some text, that was deemed unnecessary, add to the improved layout on each step.

The Start step presents the User with a question to answer.

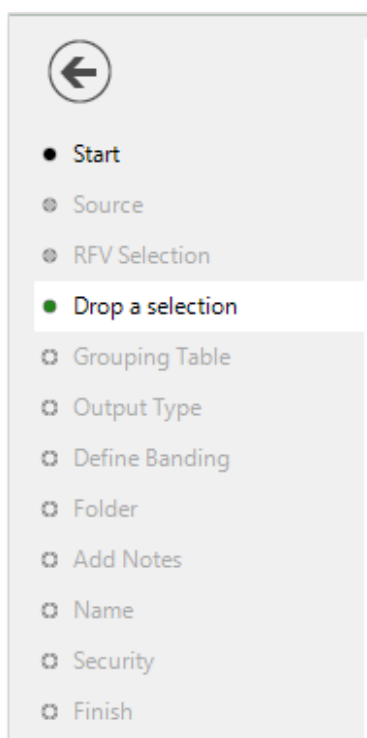
- Click on the radio button **No, I don't have an RFV selection**

With this type of question step, when an answer has been chosen the wizard will automatically move on to the next relevant step, without having to click on a Next button.

In this example the wizard has now moved on to the **Drop a selection** step.

- Look at the left panel of the step

A back button has now appeared in the top left of the panel, allowing the User to return to the previous step. Also, the icon in front of each step name has changed in some instances. A black dot denotes a completed step, a grey dot denotes a step that has been skipped and a coloured dot (green in this example) denotes the step currently displayed.



By continuing to complete each step, and clicking the Next button where necessary, the process will conclude by creating a virtual variable with this particular wizard.
